

Directions for use with the Skin Care Class Guide:

After Moisturizer, skip the foundation page and romance the Miracle Set. Then teach Advanced Color Application with both of these pages. Then move on to referrals and the rest of the Skin Care Class Guide as usual.

NOW WE ARE GOING USE PRIMERS TO MAKE YOUR MAKE-UP LAST ALL DAY!

- 1. # 6 is your FOUNDATION PRIMER**—apply with fingers all over face (use full-sized demo)
 - A. This primer will make your foundation look flawless all day!
 - B. It has SPF 15 to reinforce protection from the sun.
 - C. We call this “spackle for your cracks”
- 2. # 7 is your EYESHADOW PRIMER**—apply with ring fingers on EYE LIDS, from lash to brow
 - A. This will prevent your eye shadow from creasing for up to 18 hours (even with sweating)
 - B. Keeps your color “true” and photo-ready

Now we'll apply Foundation!

1. Foundation is always a part of a good skin care routine.
2. Instruct application—in large well.
 - A. Start at the center of your face, apply to cheeks and forehead. Finish by blending outward. (You can use the foundation brush if you like, if it is the liquid foundation brush, you can offer it to her as a gift!)

Now we are going to use the FACIAL HIGHLIGHTING PEN

1. Apply with ring fingers under the eye area where it is dark
2. Pat until it disappears
3. This is a concealer that is designed for under the eyes, it has light reflectors to help you look rested

Color Application: USE THE COMPLETE BRUSH COLLECTION!!!

- 1. Cheeks—with “Cheek” Brush**
- 2. Lips**—scrape some lip primer into small wells on the upper right corner and apply with finger
 - Apply Lipstick, then the gloss in #8
- 3. Eyes**—
 1. Light color—use “**Eye Color**” Brush to apply crease to brow
 2. Medium color—use “**Eye Color Brush** to apply crease to lash line
 3. Dark color—use “**Eye Crease**” Brush to apply on outer crease and lash line to make a “>” shape
 4. Eyebrows (optional) - use the “**Eyeliner/Eyebrow**” brush to define eyebrows with eye shadow color (almond, hazelnut, or espresso)
 5. Eyeliner—eyeliner sample or dark eye color sample with damp angle brush
 - Use “**Eye Smudger**” Brush to give eyeliner a “smoky” look

Optional: Facial Contouring with Bronzer and Highlighter

1. Using the “Powder” or “Cheek” brush, apply Bronzing powder to outer edges of face and under cheek bones in a “3” shape on each side
2. Using the “Powder” or “Cheek” brush, apply Highlighting powder to upper cheek bones, temples, center of forehead, and chin

4. Translucent Powder— use “Powder” Brush to apply all over face

Now we are going to “set” your make up!

1. Apply with Powder Brush
2. This has light-scattering properties that soften the appearance of pores, fine lines, and wrinkles! It also controls shine ALL DAY!

5. Lash Primer—plumps the lashes while helping your mascara to last all day

6. Mascara—(USE A SEPARATE WAND)

7. FINISHING SPRAY!

Now we are going to use our new finishing spray!

1. CLOSE EYES!
2. Spray in “T” and “X” shape on face
3. This will set your whole look and prevent any running—even if you cry! It give you that “freshly applied” look ALL DAY!
