

Fabulous Gift Wrapping

(without breaking the bank)



This beautiful Satin Hands Set start with.....THIS!

What do you need???

- Long and narrow piece of cellophane
(all 4 sides do NOT need to come up to top, only front and back)
- 3+ pieces of nice wired ribbon (find on clearance to save \$) 4-8 inches long
- 3+ pieces of sparkly or colored tulle (find on clearance or on sale) 4-8 inches long
- 3+ pieces of curling ribbon cut long and curled
- Piece of white or colored wrapping paper
- Shred - I like to use iridescent
- Candy or small, inexpensive little sparkly things
- Glue Dots (glue spots, Zots, etc)
- TRANSPARENT tape, frosted tape shows and transparent tape doesn't. :-)
- Piece of cardboard for a base, cut just barely bigger than the product footprint
(NOTE: this piece is from our boxes that product comes in!! FREE to us)





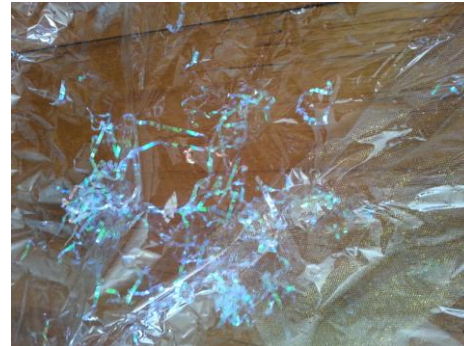
Wrap the cardboard with the wrapping paper.



Begin placing the product on the base by using the glue dots



VOILA! Ready to wrap!



Lay out the cellophane and place a little shred in the center where you will place the base.



Here is what it should look like.



Now add MORE shred...FABULOUS!!!



Add some shiny candy/things



Fold the front of the cellophane tight up to the top bring the back piece up to meet and tie with one of the pieces of curling ribbon to secure.



Here I have 3 pieces of ribbon, 3 pieces of tulle and 2 more pieces of curling ribbon to work with



I like to start with the longest piece of ribbon so it starts the "bow" in the back. I prefer wired ribbon because it is so much easier to work with and holds shape really well. Lay the piece of ribbon against the knot in the curling ribbon that you used to secure the cellophane and then secure it with the curling ribbon.



Then secure a piece of Tulle, Ribbon, Tulle, Ribbon, and so on, until you have the curling ribbon remaining. You can work this in the middle also, I like it at the end as the "center" to my bow. You can play with this by adding more ribbon, different colors of tulle, etc. Just keep your budget in mind and DO NOT break the bank on this. You can wrap a TON of gifts with 1 good sized roll of cellophane, 1 roll of ribbon and 1 roll of tulle.



To finish off the sides and back, pull the sides to the back and tape in place with the transparent tape. This is where the TRANSPARENT tape is important, it hides all the flaws.
