



WHEN TO CLEAN OUT YOUR MAKEUP

Concealer

Liquid concealers should be replaced after 1 year, while powders and sticks can last for 2 years. Keep an eye out for color change which means it has expired.

Cheek Color

Powder cheek colors should be replaced after 2 years. Cream cheek colors have a shorter shelf life and should be replaced after 1 year.

Powder

Powders should be kept in a cool, dry place, not your bathroom! Pressed powder can last for 2 years, and loose powder can last for up to 3 years.



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
